Terms of Reference (TOR) for Individual Contractors

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Under the direct supervision of the Chief Network Support Section, the incumbent is responsible for the following duties:

- Assist in the interfacing activities of multi-layer LAN and WAN switches, routers, bridges multiplexers and concentrators.
- Assist in the survey and planning regarding the installation/upgrade of mission VoIP telephone system.
- Assist in the installation and configuration of LAN network equipment.
- Assist in the installation, commissioning and maintenance/repair of a range of medium and high capacity VoIP terminals, computerized telephone accounting and billings systems.
- Action work orders assigned by the unit supervisor; assist in the programming, testing and pre-commissioning of all new equipment in the workshops prior to deployment.
- Assist the supervisor with the installation of equipment and implementation of projects.
- Assist in the upgrade, enhancement and modification of telephone equipment to meet required VoIP specifications.
- Assist in the implementation of regular and preventative maintenance for all equipment and accessories in the unit.
- Assist in coordinating the factory calibration and repair of ICT test equipment.
- Perform other duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS AND SKILLS

Education: Possession of High School Diploma or equivalent. Supplemental courses and training plus technical certification in electronic telecommunications or other related field. Practical training should include a wide range of telecommunications expertise.
